

Re: Industrial Scaffolding – Work in Canada – Scaffolding Practical Evaluation

To qualify for future Scaffold Erector work in Canada, members must attend and pass the 5-Day "Scaffolding Qualification – Industrial ITC" course held at the UBC International Training Center (ITC) in Las Vegas. Scaffolding Qualification – Industrial ITC courses will be scheduled at the ITC based on demand for scaffold erectors in Canada. To prepare for the training, members must meet the following prerequisites:

- Be a Journeyman
- Have current full Scaffold Erector Qualification training (Welded Frame/Mobile Tower, Systems and Tube & Clamp)
- Have current Fall Protection or Construction Fall Protection training
- Pass a Hands-on Scaffolding Practical Evaluation at a Local UBC Training Center

Members will not be allowed to attend the Scaffolding Qualification – Industrial ITC course at the ITC in Las Vegas unless they first meet all of the above prerequisites.

The 3-Hour Scaffolding Practical Evaluation Members must have a current full Scaffold Erector Qualification (Welded Frame/Mobile Tower, Systems, and Tube & Clamp) to be eligible for the Scaffolding Practical Evaluation. The evaluation must be given at a Local Training Center by a current UBC Scaffold Erector instructor. After a member has passed the Scaffolding Practical Evaluation the Local Training Center must post the results in TRAIN.

The Scaffolding Practical Evaluation is also embedded within the Scaffolding Qualification – Industrial class held at a Local Training Center.

Members who previously passed a Scaffolding Qualification – Industrial ITC member course or Scaffolding Qualification – Industrial Train The Trainer course held at the ITC have received the Scaffolding Practical Evaluation entry in TRAIN.

Scaffolding Qualification – Industrial member courses can still be taught at Local Training Centers and members will be qualified to work in the United States; however this class does not meet the requirements for future Scaffold work in Canada. Only Scaffolding Qualification – Industrial ITC courses taken at the ITC meet these requirements.
