Qualifications for the Apprenticeship

- MUST BE ATLEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE
- MUST BE A HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE OR EQUIVALENT AS RECOGNIZED BY LOCAL SCHOOL AUTHORITIES. SIGNED AFFIDAVIT AT TIME OF APPLICATION, PROOF REQUIRED AT TIME OF INDENTURE.
- MUST BE PHYSICALLY ABLE TO PERFORM WORK, SIGNED AFFIDAVIT REQUIRED.
- MUST HAVE RELIABLE TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM JOBSITES AND SCHOOL, SIGNED AFFIDAVIT REQUIRED.
- MUST SUBMIT TO AND PASS A DRUG TEST UPON INDENTURE.
- BE EVALUATED BY AN AUTHORIZED TRAINING REPRESENTATIVE
- IF APPLICANT IS A VETERAN, A COPY OF DD-214 IS REQUIRED AT TIME OF OFFER.
- PROOF OF G.E.D./T.A.S.C/DIPLOMA & DMV PICTURE ID AT TIME OF INDENTURE.

How to Apply



The Northeast Carpenters Apprenticeship Program is accredited through the NYS Dept. of Labor and the NYS Department of Education. The 5 year program consists of 4 weeks of school/technical training per year, combined with a Minimum of 5200 hours of on the job training over 5 years. The training program is sponsored through employer contributions.

The Northeast Regional Council of Carpenters has established Regional Training Centers that contain state of the art facilities and instructors. We offer every apprentice the opportunity to receive the training necessary for state and national trade certifications. When provided with the skills, knowledge and technology required in today's construction industry the union carpenter will remain unsurpassed in performance and superiority.

ALL TRAINING IS AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO MEMBERS.

At the Training Center

All classes are supervised by certified instructors who are experienced journeyman carpenters. The instructor is available to answer questions, assign projects, demonstrate proper procedures and assist the apprentices as they complete the projects. Instructors also spend a considerable amount of time with the apprentices teaching them technical aspects of the trade in a classroom setting.



On the Job

Hands-on training in addition to classroom instruction is the best way to allow our apprentices to learn the new technologies and new procedures of the ever changing construction industry. Apprentices work with Journey-level workers to learn the skills needed to build successful careers. All apprentices receive an employer paid contribution for health insurance above their hourly wage, and a contribution to the pension fund.

- Applications and standardized math tests will only be offered during the dates and times listed on the back.
- You will be contacted to be interviewed by the joint apprenticeship committee.
- During the interview you will be credited with any type of applicable schooling or training, trade related work experience, military service, and your score on the standardized math test. All of these serve to determine your ranking score.
- You will then be added to your area's ranking list and will remain on that list for a maximum of two (2) years.
- We could potentially contact you at any time during that period with an opportunity to join the program.
- We contact the applicant with the highest score on the list in the area in which the opening in the program occurs. We will continue down the list if the first applicant turns the opening down or if we have multiple openings.
